**Tasting Notes:**

1999 - The nose has extremely complex layers of dark fruits, exotic dry fruits, cola, hazelnut and vanilla with silky and spices (clove). The wine is well structured, elegant and seductive. It shows concentration with a long ripe finish.

A fine propriety Bordeaux blend is the proud offering of Melka Wines. The Melkas chose a young Basque artist, Michel Hacala, for the beautiful image that graces their label. The painting's unique and vibrant colors express the energy of harvest and the spirit of youth. A transparent outline forms a loosely connected square representing a union of two cultures, vineyards and varietals' as well as the union between Cherie and Philippe.

We are in love with this wine because of it's luscious concentration coupled with an elegance and finesse that has become a Métisse signature.
