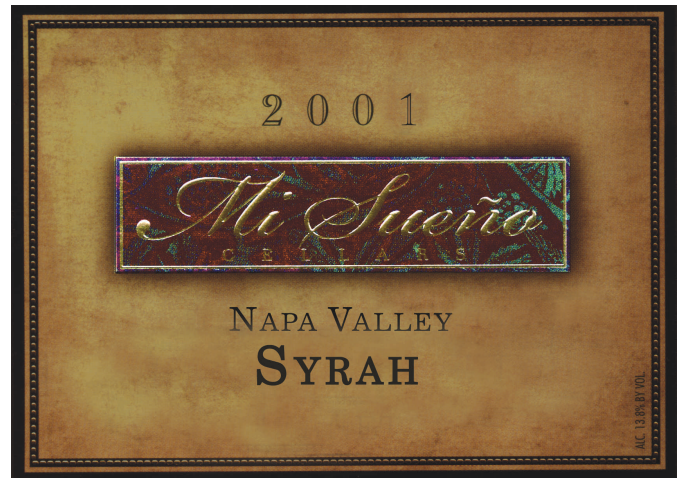


**Mi Sueño

Tasting Notes:

Saturated red/black color. Scents of plum, currant, pepper, toasting bread, and white chocolate make this a heady mix. This is a big, rich wine that commands attention. The flavors of black and red fruits combine with new leather and chocolate to make this a wine with wonderful vibrancy and vitality. Ideal drinking: 2003-2012.

Winemaking Notes:

Syrah is the newest wine in the Mi Sueño portfolio. Our Syrah grapes come from two vineyards east of the city of Napa. These vineyards differ from each other in many ways, and the grapes we harvest from them complement each other beautifully.

The Que Syrah Vineyard has old vines planted on a steep hillside with shallow soils. The vines struggle to survive, and they produce grapes with firm tannins, and tremendous complexity. The Reichow Vineyard has younger vines planted in the rich soil of the Napa Valley floor. This vineyard produces grapes with rich, supple fruit. Together, the grapes from these two vineyards yield a concentrated wine with a classic structure. This wine promises to age gracefully.
