The 2002 Mi Sueno Cabernet is produced from vineyards on the southeast side of Napa in a region called "Coombsville". In the glass this wine exhibits a perfume of bramble, dried herbs & coffee while the opaque crimson color coats the glass. Bursting with flavors of dried blackberry, sage and bittersweet chocolate this wine shows seamless oak integration, high extract and excellent purity. This wine should drink well for the next 15-20 years
