Garnet red in color with a multi-dimensional nose. Aromas of this wine range from spring, ripe cranberry-like fruit to a smokey, toasty character coming mostly from older barrels. In the mouth, it is soft, rich, and round, yet has the juicy, lively palate of Sangiovese. I really like the raspberry cocoa-like flavors that the nose leads one into. A very enticing, easy-to-drink wine with a seamless balance and lovely round mouthfeel.
