In the nose, the fruit is of currants and black cherry with hints of toastiness from a variety of barrels that we used on this wine. The flavors are consistent with the aromas. This is a big, ripe, mouth-filling wine. Enjoyable now, but will age nicely because of it's structure and balance. We hope you will enjoy it!
