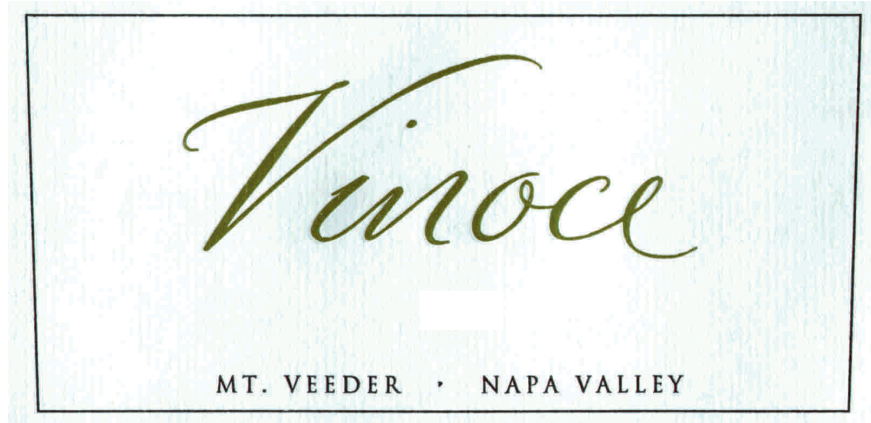




Vinoce Vineyards

Tasting Notes:

Smooth, rich and elegant. This wine has a lovely nose of citrus and honeydew, with a hint of spice lemongrass. The mouthfeel is round and refined in texture with a lingering finish that is clean and refreshing.

Winemaking Notes:

- Harvest Data: Grapes picked in september
- Average Sugar at Harvest: 23.5 Brix
- Fermentation: Our fermentation is completed in stainless tanks followed by 1 month in French Oak barrells.

- Blend: 97% Sauvignon Blanc, 3% Chardonnay
- Alcohol: 14.1%
- Appellation: Rutherford, Napa Valley

The 2001 Sauvignon Blanc was sourced from a highly regarded vineyard in Rutherford in the heart of the Napa Valley.
